The abstract (up to one page) for Conference MITRE-2023 should be written in English, LaTeX 2e, according to the sample below. For Section 5 Romanian is also acceptable.

Abstract for Section 5 can be written in MS Word, (up to one page, A5, Times New Roman, 11 pt., text only, without graphs, tables, figures, etc.).

Please send the abstract files with the extensions .tex and .pdf (Sections 1-4, e.g., ionescu2.tex and ionescu2.pdf), respectively, .doc or .docx (Section 5, e.g., ionescu5.doc), having as a title the name of the first author and the number of the section.
